WHY DO WE NEED FIRE DRILLS AT WORK?

How people behave in high-pressure situations, such as fires, can vary but this factor can be hugely important when it comes to effective evacuation. Fire drills allow staff to practice evacuation procedures in a simulated situation to ensure they are fully aware of how to exit the building safely.

The more familiar staff are with fire drill procedures, the higher the chance that staff remain safe and well during an emergency. Regular fire drills will help to underpin the correct procedures, removing panic and uncertainty for all concerned.

Fire drill is also an important tool to analyse how effective the evacuation procedure is and how effective the exit routes were, so that changes can be made to improve the strategy in the future.
